WHITE WINES

PINOT GRIGIO

Barone Fini - 23

Classic Italian pinot grigio, fresh with medium body and acidity, green apple notes; good for sipping and to accompany a variety of seafood and lighter dishes

Alois Lageder - 22 **SPLIT BOTTLE**

Brilliant straw yellow color with green shimmer and with flowery and spicy notes - this winery is one of the first ones in Italy to convert to biodynamic viticulture

Hofstätter - 41

Great acidity with beautiful notes of citrus and pears

CHARDONNAY

Whitewater Hill Barrel Select - 30 - **local winery**

Lightly oaked local chardonnay

Frescobaldi Pomino - 49

This is actually a blend of chardonnay and pinot bianco—elegant, well balanced and fresh

Vie di Romans 2015 - 66

A beautiful, intense and elegant chardonnay from the Northern Italian region of Friuli—matured for 9 months on lees—no oak

Mezzacorona - 35 - **MAGNUM BOTTLE**

PINOT BIANCO

Tramin - 37

This wine comes from high in the Alpine region of Trentino Alto Adige—it is rich, dry, with great acidity—beautiful as an aperitif or with seafood dishes

VERMENTINO

Argiolas Costamolino - 32

Argiolas is one of the most famous wineries in the island of Sardegna and their philosophy is to use only indigenous grapes. This wine is 95% vermentino and 5% other Sardinian grapes with partial malolactic fermentation to add richness - delicate citrus flavors with notes of tropical fruits and honey; great acidity makes it a very food-friendly wine

Antinori Tenuta Guado al Tasso DOCG - 44 - **new addition**

An amazing, well-balanced vermentino from Bolgheri

RIBOLLA GIALLA

Tenuta Sant Helena Fantinel - 46

Historic, indigenous variety of the Friuli region in Northeastern Italy. This is a lively, dry, full body white wine that can be enjoyed with food or sitting on a patio on a hot day.

GRECO DI TUFO

Terredora di Paolo—44

Classic white wine from the area around Naples—floral, dry, with great acidity—great summer wine

ROERO ARNEIS

Monchiero Carbone - 41

The is one of the best whites from Piemonte- elegant, dry, medium body with a subtle effervescence on the palate; citrus and melon aroma with hints of almonds

SOAVE

Suavia Soave Classico — 32

A “must try” wine—100% garganega grapes—dry, medium to full body, high acidity, notes of pears, apples and almonds - elegant and harmonious soave

RIESLING

Carlson - 25 - **local winery**

Sweet and floral, light

NURAGUS

Argiolas s'Elegas - 42

This is a very unique and rare varietal grown in very small quantities in Sardinia - rich, floral, and citrusy with aromas of peaches, nuts, and herbs

GEWÜRZTRAMINER

Carlson - 25 - **local winery**

Aromatic and floral with tropical fruit notes

Tramin Nussbaumer 2011 - 94

Amazing award-winning wine from high in the Italian Alps - single vineyard Gewürztraminer - full body, dry, intensely aromatic with of aromas of stone fruits, exotic spices, tropical fruits, and spicy notes

GAVI

La Marchesa - 36

100 % cortese grapes from Southern Piedmont—dry, fruity, high acidity— a light, fun wine

VERNACCIA

San Quirico - 32 - organic

Traditional white wine from the hills around Siena and San Geminiano in Tuscany - dry and crisp with lemon, almond and herb notes

CHARDONNAY BLEND

Nino Negri Ca' Brione 2015 - 76

Made with partially dried chardonnay and sauvignon blanc grapes, incrocio Manzoni grapes and some local nebbiolo or chiavennasca grapes - the must ferments and matures inside French oak barriques for 8 months. The result is an amazing full body white wine and a rare example of white wine from the Valtellina area of Northern Lombardy

MOSCATO

Umberto Fiore Moscato d'Asti - 39

Sweet, bubbly, low alcohol - great for dessert or sweeter palates

Cascinetta Vietti Moscato d'Asti—22 **SPLIT BOTTLE**

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Tenuta Luisa Sauvignon Blanc - 38

Beautiful tropical fruits notes, bright and supple

Colterris - 44 - local winery

High acidity, grapefruit notes, award-winning

Russiz Superiore Collio 2015/2016 - 65

From one of the most famous winemakers in Northern Italy, Marco Felluga, this is a complex, full body sauvignon blanc - 15% of the must was fermented in oak to add complexity - green pepper and pink grapefruit on the nose, lemon and grapefruit on the palate

VERDICCHIO

Garofoli Macrina - 31

This is the wine from my Italian summers spent by the Adriatic sea. The name is due to the hint of green hue in the color, "verde" in Italian - it's the traditional wine of seafood dishes and cold aperitif on that stretch of the Adriatic coast - notes of ripe peaches and apples with hints of tropical fruits

ROSE', BUBBLY, AND DESSERT WINES

BERA BRACHETTO D'ACQUI - 47

Sweet, bubbly, beautiful pink color, low alcohol, strawberry notes, 100% brachetto - basically a red Moscato

PROSECCO DA LUCA - 8 - mini bottle, a bit more than a glass

MEROTTO PROSECCO SUPERIORRE COLBELO EXTRA DRY - 37 - delicious prosecco

ROTARI ROSE' BRUT - 38

Made with the traditional method used for champagne using pinot noir and chardonnay grapes from Trentino

LEONE DE CASTRIS' FIVE ROSES - 38

Dry Italian Rose' with gentle tannins, bright acidity, and red berry and floral notes

UMBERTO FIORE MOSCATO D'ASTI - 39

CASCINETTA VIETTI MOSCATO D'ASTI - 22 - SPLIT BOTTLE

WHITEWATER HILL ZERO BELOW - 40 - local winery 500 ml bottle

Late harvest chardonnay, sweet and intense

MERLOT

Two Rivers Winery - 33 - **local winery**

PINOT NOIR

Lechthaler - 32

Light bodied and dry

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Two Rivers Winery - 40 - **local winery**

Colterris - 47 - **local winery**

Scaia Torre Mellotti - 38

From Veneto, this cabernet is made with a combination of fresh grapes and partly dried grapes, which gives the wine intensity and dark fruit notes

Falesco Marciliano 2012 - 94

From one of the most famous winemakers in Italy, Riccardo Cotarella, comes this blend of the best of the estate grown Cabernet Sauvignons. Aged 16 months in oak, it is probably the best Cabernet Sauvignon produced in Central Italy—full body, elegant wine, with deep notes that keep developing as you drink through the bottle—a real beauty!

CABERNET FRANC

Colterris - 47 - **local winery**

Russiz Superiore Collio 2015/2016 - 69

From one of the most famous winemakers in Italy, Marco Felluga - the most unique and intense cabernet franc I have ever tasted - spicy, full body, complex, elegant

BONARDA

Castello di Luzzano - 35

Bonarda is a grape grown in small areas of Italy between Lombardy, Emilia, and Piemonte—ruby red color, high acidity, dry, intense

SWEET RED WINE

Carlson Sweet Baby Red - 25 - **local winery**

SALICE SALENTINO

Cantele Riserva - 29

Great value for a wine that is aged three years in a mix of stainless steel and oak casks

TEROLDEGO ROTALIANO

Lechthaler - 30

One of the lesser known wines of Northern Italy - an easy drinking wine that combines ripe fruit notes with earthy tones

Castel Firmian Nerofino—32

This wine is actually a 50-50 blend of Teroldego and Lagrain, the two most important red varietals of the Dolomites—full body, fruity, dry, well balanced—a great new discovery

SANGIOVESE

Di Majo Norante - 25 - organically grown

CHIANTI

Castello di Bossi Chianti Classico - 41

Nozzole Chianti Classico Riserva 2015/2016 - 47

Aged two years in barrel and one year in bottle

Castello di Querceto Il Picchio Chianti Classico Riserva 2015 - 131

Single vineyard chianti only produced in exceptional years with the best of the grapes from this vineyard in the Classico area of Chianti- aged 12-14 months in oak barrels

Nozzole Chianti Classico Riserva 2014 - 35—**SPLIT BOTTLE**

Selvapiana Chianti Rufina - 80—**MAGNUM BOTTLE**

SANGIOVESE GROSSO

San Polo Rubio - 36

Heavy extraction gives this wine a ruby color and nice fruit - great value

Altesino Brunello di Montalcino 2014 - 143

Classic Brunello wine with strong tannins and full body

Altesino Brunello di Montalcino Montosili 2008 - 308

Single vineyard, powerful Brunello - a really special treat

Il Poggione Rosso di Montalcino 2017 - 56

Basically a “baby” Brunello without the steep price tag

Camigliano Brunello di Montalcino 2013 - 88

Argiano Brunello di Montalcino 2014 - 109

Very approachable Brunello, powerful and intense but without the sharpness of most other young Brunello wines

VINO NOBILE DI MONTEPULCIANO

Fattoria del Cerro 2014 - 38

Also made from sangiovese grapes, vino nobile comes exclusively from the area around the hill town of Montepulciano and is not to be confused with the montepulciano grape that produces the wine with the same name

Poliziano 2012 - 39 - **SPLIT BOTTLE**

Poliziano Asinone 2014 - 133—single vineyard—only made in exceptional years—a powerful wine

MORELLINO

Poliziano Lohsa - 34

Another form of sangiovese grown along the Tuscan coast—produced by one of the best wineries in the Montepulciano area

SANGIOVESE BLENDS

Rocca di Frassinello Le Sughere 2015 - 57

From the Tuscan coast—blend of sangiovese, merlot and cabernet sauvignon

Monte Antico - 26

Affordable Supertuscan blend of sangiovese, merlot and cabernet sauvignon

Monte Antico 2014 - 49 - **MAGNUM BOTTLE**

SAGRANTINO

RC2 Sagrantino di Montefalco DOCG 2014 - 114

One of the lesser known jewels of the Italian wine varietals. Produced in the Umbria region for centuries, this is a full body wine with lots of black fruit and tobacco on the nose, strong but smooth tannins—the winemaker, Riccardo Cotarella, is one of the top winemakers in Italy and only made 6000 bottles of this wine.

GRIGNOLINO

Castello di Neive - 44

A food friendly wine with crisp acidity, refreshing red fruit notes, and light tannins—easy drinking—one of the lesser known wines from the Piemonte region

SCHIOPETTINO

Ronchi di Pietro - 38

Another of the lesser known wines from Northern Italy—dry, medium to full body, earthy

NERO D'AVOLA

Feudo Maccari - 35

The most important red grape of Sicily—medium body with smooth tannins

SHIRAZ/SYRAH

Whitewater Hill Shiraz— 38 - Local Winery

Nice and peppery, one of the few shiraz produced in the valley

MONICA

Argiolas Perdera —33

Indigenous grape from the island of Sardegna, rarely seen anywhere else - medium body, with gentle tannins, red berry, herbs and earthy tones - great overall food wine

CARMIGNANO

Tenuta Capezzana Barco Reale—32

Blend of sangiovese, cabernet and canaiolo according to an ancient tradition that goes back to Medici times

MALBEC

Colterris 2016 —47—local winery

One of the newest wineries in the valley but always producing some of the best wines around here

PETIT VERDOT

Colterris—48—local winery

Another beautiful wine from this estate winery—dry with full body

CORVINA BASED WINES

Sant'Antonio Scaia - 27 - it is rare to find a wine that is 100% corvina grapes - this is a great value wine

Zenato Valpolicella - 34

Perfect combination of fruity and earthy - this wine is so eclectic that it pairs well with a large number of dishes on our menu

Allegrini Palazzo della Torre—36—**Great Value, Great Wine**

This is a unique wine that contains 30% of Amarone in the blend

Zenato Amarone Classico Della Valpolicella 2013 - 136

Rich, luscious and chocolatey

Zenato Amarone Classico Della Valpolicella 2014 - 74 - **SPLIT BOTTLE**

Another great wine and a split bottle is a great way to enjoy a great wine without breaking the bank

Righetti Amarone della Valpolicella Classico 2006 - 210

A special release for this wine - only 1130 bottles made and only 18 came to Colorado

NEBBIOLO BASED WINES

Vietti Nebbiolo Perbacco 2016 - 57 - just two months short of being a Barolo!

Vietti Barolo Castiglione 2014 - 105 - one of Robert Parker's favorite wines and a great entry to Barolo wines

Travaglini Gattinara 2013 - 72

From the small producing area of Gattinara in Northern Piedmont, this wine is made like a barbaresco but without the price tag - don't forget to look at the bottle and its unique shape, which was patented by the Travaglini family in 1958

Damilano Barolo Lecinquevigne 2013 – 46 - **SPLIT BOTTLE**

A blend of wines from 5 different vineyards - aromas of leather, tobacco, and roses on the nose - dark cherries and red raspberries on the palate with strong but smooth tannins

Silvio Grasso Barolo Bricco Manzoni 2010 - 208

One of the lesser known producers of Barolo whose vineyards are located in La Morra, one of the best areas of production of Barolo wine. This particular wine presents the traditional characteristics of a Barolo in a classy and elegant way

Poderi Elia Barbaresco 2012 - 137

Full-bodied, round tannins, notes of cherry and fresh balsamic, with a long exotic fruit finish—a great value.

Ronchi Barbaresco 2015 - 78 - **new addition, great value**

Amazing Barbaresco estate bottled by Ronchi di Giancarlo Rocca

Produttori del Barbaresco Riserva Ovello 2013 - 137

Produttori del Barbaresco Riserva Pora 2013 - 137

Each is a single vineyard Barbaresco, aged 3 years in oak and 8 months in bottle—powerful and intense yet refined—each received 95 points from Wine Spectator!

Barolo is considered the king of Piedmont wines while Barbaresco is considered the queen, intense but more approachable and softer than the powerful barolo

BARBERA

Araldica Barbera d'Asti Albera 2016 - 25

Wine from Piemonte aged in oak casks, giving it a warm, smoky aroma

Araldica Barbera d'Asti Superiore 2015 - 48 - Fruity and lively

Vietti Barbera d'Alba Scarrone 2016 - 98

Amazing barbera treated with the care of a barolo

AGLIANICO

Bisceglia Terre di Vulcano - 33

Aglianico del Vulture from Basilicata and the slopes of a long extinguished volcano - full body, dry with lots of minerality coming from the particular soil the vines grow in

Terredora di Paolo Fatica Contadina Taurasi 2011—68

This is the famous aglianico wine that is produced from vines that grow on the slopes of Mount Vesuvius—aged for 18 months in oak barrels then in bottle for 24 months—full body, complex, with dark fruit and tobacco notes—beautiful wine

AGLIANICO BLENDS

Galardi Terra di Lavoro 2009 - 205

One of the most amazing wines of Southern Italy: Aglianico and pedirosso, the only wine produced by this winery in very small quantity every year - a rare find and one of the best expressions of aglianico grapes around

GAGLIOPPO and GAGLIOPPO BLEND

Librandi Duca di San Felice 2012 - 45

A rare find from Calabria - full body, dry, earthy yet elegant

Librandi Gravello Val di Neto Rosso 2014—66

The most important wine for the Librandi winery: a beautiful blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Gaglioppo grapes, full body, earthy and smooth

MAGLIOCCO

Librandi Magno Megonio 2014—75

My favorite wine from Calabria—made from the indigenous grape Magliocco, a very finicky grape to grow, this is a full body wine, earthy and elegantly rustic, with very smooth tannins

PRIMITIVO

Castello Monaci Piluna - 35 - full body, fruity and delicious

Mottura Stilio Primitivo di Manduria - 120 - **new addition**

Unique and interesting Primitivo made in the style of Amarone - the Primitivo grapes are dried before being pressed, giving the wine more bold and robust flavor

INTERNATIONAL STYLE BLENDS

Aia Vecchia Sor Ugo Bolgheri Superiore 2016 - 80 - **new addition**

Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot and Petit Verdot—a classic Supertuscan

Campo alla Sughera Arnione 2009 - 132

From the Bolgheri area in the Tuscan Maremma, this is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and other international varieties—complex and elegant, with soft tannins and the body to stand to some of our heavier dishes

Marchesi Antinori Il Bruciato 2016 - 53 - **new addition, great value**

Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Syrah—one of the most affordable Supertuscan wines from one of the most prestigious wineries in Bolgheri and in Italy

Poggio al Tesoro Mediterra - 41 - **new addition, great value**

Also from Bolgheri, on the Tuscan coast, this wine is a unique blend of Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc

Terre di San Leonardo—41

A beautiful blend of 40% merlot, 50% cabernet sauvignon and 10% carmenere from the Dolomites

CARIGNANO

Santadi Grotta Rossa - 27 - [great value](#)

Carignano del Sulcis is one of the lesser known grapes from Sardinia—full body, earthy yet smooth—a real jewel and one of the best values in this list

CANNONAU

Argiolas Costera - 39

From the island of Sardegna, cannonau is the same grape as garnacha in Spain and Granache in France - deliciously rustic and earthy

DOLCETTO

Fontanabianca Dolcetto d'Alba - 33 - [great value](#)

Medium body red wine from Piemonte, a great food wine

LAMBRUSCO

Tenuta Pederzana Lambrusco di Castelvetro Gibe - 34

Fruity but dry, lightly sparkly, the classic accompaniment for food from Emilia Romagna, my area of Italy—served chilled, this is a great wine to drink with most of our pastas

Cleto Chiarli Vecchia Modena - 32

Lightly Sparkling with notes of red cherry, strawberry, and tangerine zest—crisp acidity

FREISA

Borgogno Langhe Freisa 2014 - 53

One of the lesser known grapes of Piemonte—medium body, red cherries, pleasant tannins, good acidity

MONTEPULCIANO and MONTEPULCIANO BLENDS

Valle Reale San Calisto 2010 - 98

Organically grown - a cru from the oldest vines at the winery - rich, full body, with soft tannins - award winner every year

Di Majo Norante Ramitello Biferno Rosso - 34

A blend of 80% montepulciano and 20% aglianico from Molise—a great value for the quality of this wine—intense, elegant, with dark fruit, licorice and leather notes—dry but with soft tannins

LAGREIN

Alois Lageder - 53

From the Dolomites—full body with smooth tannins—a delicious wine among the lesser known varieties in America, but produced for years in the Alpine regions.

REFOSCO DAL PEDUNCOLO ROSSO

Marco Felluga Ronco dei Moreri 2013 – 38 - [great value](#)

Indigenous grape of Friuli, in Northeastern Italy, at the border with the former Yugoslavia. This particular wine is aged in oak for 12 months then in bottle for 6 months. Intense red and black fruit notes, full body but elegant and approachable
