Estate produced in Palisade from Cabernet Sauvignon grapes—slightly off-dry with great acidity and strawberry and raspberry notes—Glass 9 , Bottle 44

BERA BRACHETTO D'ACQUI

Sweet, bubbly, beautiful pink color, low alcohol, and strawberry notes—100% Brachetto grapes—basically a red moscato—Bottle 47

Dry with hints of apricots and citrus—Bottle 28

NINO FRANCO RUSTICO

A very old producer in the heart of Prosecco area—medium body, elegant, with plenty of citrus notes, great acidity, and luscious bubbles—Bottle 40

WHITE WINES

PINOT GRIGIO

Barone Fini - 28

Classic Italian pinot grigio, fresh with medium body and acidity, green apple notes; good for sipping and to accompany a variety of seafood and lighter dishes

Alois Lageder - 22 - **SPLIT BOTTLE**

Brilliant straw yellow color with green shimmer and with flowery and spicy notes - this winery is one of the first ones in Italy to convert to biodynamic viticulture

J. Hofstätter - 47

Great acidity with beautiful notes of citrus and pears

CHARDONNAY

Whitewater Hill Barrel Select - 31 - **local winery**

Lightly oaked local chardonnay

Frescobaldi Pomino - 49

This is actually a blend of chardonnay and pinot bianco—elegant, well balanced and fresh

Vie di Romans 2015 - 66

A beautiful, intense and elegant chardonnay from the Northern Italian region of Friuli—matured for 9 months on lees—no oak

PINOT BIANCO

Tramin - 52

This wine comes from high in the Alpine region of Trentino Alto Adige—it is rich, dry, with great acidity—beautiful as an aperitif or with seafood dishes

VERMENTINO

Argiolas Costamolino - 32

Argiolas is one of the most famous wineries in the island of Sardinia and their philosophy is to use only indigenous grapes. This wine is 95% vermentino and 5% other Sardinian grapes with partial malolactic fermentation to add richness - delicate citrus flavors with notes of tropical fruits and honey; great acidity makes it a very food-friendly wine

GRECO DI TUFO

Terredora di Paolo - 44

Classic white wine from the area around Naples—floral, dry, with great acidity—great summer wine

MÜLLER THURGAU

This is a white wine grape variety used predominately in Germany, Switzerland, and the Alpine region of Italy. It was created in 1882 by crossing Riesling and Madeleine Royal grapes by Doctor Müller Thurgau.

Fresh and fruity wine with hints of white peach and notes of sage and thyme—refreshing wine as an aperitif or paired with fish, fresh cheeses, and salads

ROERO ARNEIS

Monchiero Carbone - 56

This is one of the best whites from Piemonte- elegant, dry, medium body with a subtle effervescence on the palate; citrus and melon aroma with hints of almonds

SOAVE

Suavia Soave Classico - 35

A “must try” wine—100% garganega grapes—dry, medium to full body, high acidity, notes of pears, apples and almonds - elegant and harmonious soave

RIESLING

Carlson - 25 - **local winery**

Sweet and floral, light

NURAGUS

Argiolas s'Elegas - 42

This is a very unique and rare varietal grown in very small quantities in Sardinia - rich, floral, and citrusy with aromas of peaches, nuts, and herbs

MOSCATO

Cascinetta Vietti Moscato d'Asti - 26 - **SPLIT BOTTLE**

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Tenuta Luisa Sauvignon Blanc - 40

Beautiful tropical fruits notes, bright and supple

Colterris - 44 - **local winery**

High acidity, grapefruit notes, award-winning

Russiz Superiore Collio 2015/2016 - 65

From one of the most famous winemakers in Northern Italy, Marco Felluga, this is a complex, full body sauvignon blanc - 15% of the must was fermented in oak to add complexity - green pepper and pink grapefruit on the nose, lemon and grapefruit on the palate

RED WINES

MERLOT

Two Rivers Winery - 33 - local winery

Whitewater Hill—38—local winery

SYRAH

Whitewater Hill Shiraz - 44 - local winery - Rich notes of black pepper and plum. Full palate with soft plum, black raspberries.

PINOT NOIR

Lechthaler - 32

Light bodied and dry

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Two Rivers Winery - 40 - local winery

CABERNET FRANC

Colterris - 47 - local winery

Russiz Superiore Collio 2017 - 69

From one of the most famous winemakers in Italy, Marco Felluga - the most unique and intense cabernet franc I have ever tasted - spicy, full body, complex, elegant

SWEET RED WINE

Carlson Sweet Baby Red - 25 - local winery

LOCAL BLEND

Whitewater Hill Ethereal - 60 - local winery Blend of Cab Franc, Merlot, and Syrah. Rich, complex wine with balanced oak and dark berries. Full bodied with soft tannins and a warm intense finish.

St. Vincent

Whitewater Hill St. Vincent - 43 - local winery Indigenous grape to the United States. Almost like an American version of Sangiovese. Red currant and raspberry nose. Cranberry and apple flavors on the palate with a dried herb finish.

CHIANTI

Castello di Bossi Chianti Classico - 41

Nozzole Chianti Classico Riserva 2018- 47

Aged two years in barrel and one year in bottle

Castello di Querceto Il Picchio Chianti Classico Riserva 2015 - 131

Single vineyard chianti only produced in exceptional years with the best of the grapes from this vineyard in the Classico area of Chianti- aged 12-14 months in oak barrels

Nozzole Chianti Classico Riserva 2014 - 35 - **SPLIT BOTTLE**

Querceto Chianti Classico Riserva 2015 - 50 - Aged 10-12 months in barriques, A dry wine with ripe red fruits, plum notes, and elegant tannins

SANGIOVESE GROSSO

Altesino Brunello di Montalcino Montosili 2008 - 308

Single vineyard, powerful Brunello - a really special treat

Camigliano Brunello di Montalcino 2015 - 92

Argiano Brunello di Montalcino 2015 - 115

Very approachable Brunello, powerful and intense but without the sharpness of most other young Brunello wines

VINO NOBILE DI MONTEPULCIANO

Fattoria del Cerro 2017 - 47

Also made from sangiovese grapes, vino nobile comes exclusively from the area around the hill town of Montepulciano and is not to be confused with the montepulciano grape that produces the wine with the same name

Poliziano Asinone 2016- 133—single vineyard—only made in exceptional years—a powerful wine

MORELLINO

Poliziano Lohsa - 34

Another form of sangiovese grown along the Tuscan coast—produced by one of the best wineries in the Montepulciano area

SANGIOVESE

Di Majo Norante - 27 - organically grown

NERO D'AVOLA

Feudo Maccari - 46

The most important red grape of Sicily—medium body with smooth tannins

MONICA

Argiolas Perdera —36

Indigenous grape from the island of Sardegna, rarely seen anywhere else - medium body, with gentle tannins, red berry, herbs and earthy tones - great overall food wine

MALBEC

Colterris 2017 —47—local winery

One of the newest wineries in the valley but always producing some of the best wines around here

PETIT VERDOT

Colterris 2017—52—local winery

Another beautiful wine from this estate winery—dry with full body

CORVINA BASED WINES

Zenato Valpolicella - 34

Perfect combination of fruity and earthy - this wine is so eclectic that it pairs well with a large number of dishes on our menu

Allegrini Palazzo della Torre—42—Great Value, Great Wine

This is a unique wine that contains 30% of Amarone in the blend

Zenato Amarone Classico Della Valpolicella 2015 - 136

Rich, luscious and chocolatey

Zenato Amarone Classico Della Valpolicella 2014 - 76- **SPLIT BOTTLE**

Another great wine and a split bottle is a great way to enjoy a great wine without breaking the bank

Righetti Amarone della Valpolicella Classico 2008 - 270

A special release for this wine - only 1130 bottles made and only 18 came to Colorado

TEROLDEGO ROTALIANO

Mezzacorona Teroldego Rotaliano NOS - 2011 - 88

Only made in exceptional vintages with grapes hand picked from the best vineyards. A dry velvety wine, with blackberry, leather, and black truffle notes. Very food friendly wine.

Castel Firmian Nerofino - 2014 - 32

A 50/50 blend of Teroldego Rotaliano and Lagrein. A fruity, juicy wine witch pairs well with food at a very friendly price.

LAGREIN

Alois Lageder - 58

From the Dolomites—full body with smooth tannins—a delicious wine among the lesser known varietals in America, but produced for years in the Alpine regions.

NEBBIOLO BASED WINES

Vietti Nebbiolo Perbacco 2018 - 61

Just two months short of being a Barolo!

Vietti Barolo Castiglione 2016 - 118

One of Robert Parker's favorite wines and a great entry to Barolo wines

Travaglini Gattinara 2017 - 83

From the small producing area of Gattinara in Northern Piedmont, this wine is made like a barbaresco but without the price tag - don't forget to look at the bottle and its unique shape, which was patented by the Travaglini family in 1958

Damilano Barolo Lecinquevigne 2013 – 46 - **SPLIT BOTTLE**

A blend of wines from 5 different vineyards - aromas of leather, tobacco, and roses on the nose - dark cherries and red raspberries on the palate with strong but smooth tannins

Silvio Grasso Barolo Bricco Manzoni 2010 - 208

One of the lesser known producers of Barolo whose vineyards are located in La Morra, one of the best areas of production of Barolo wine. This particular wine presents the traditional characteristics of a Barolo in a classy and elegant way

Poderi Elia Barbaresco 2012 - 137

Full-bodied.

Produttori del Barbaresco Riserva Ovello 2014 - 146

**A single vineyard Barbaresco, aged 3 years in oak and 8 months in bottle—powerful and intense yet refined
Received 95 points from Wine Spectator!**

Barolo is considered the king of Piedmont wines while Barbaresco is considered the queen, intense but more approachable and softer than the powerful barolo

BARBERA

Araldica Barbera d'Asti Superiore 2015 - 48 - Fruity and lively

Vietti Barbera d'Alba Scarrone 2016 - 98

Amazing Barbera treated with the care of a Barolo

AGLIANICO

Terredora di Paolo Fatica Contadina Taurasi 2012—78

This is the famous aglianico wine that is produced from vines that grow on the slopes of Mount Vesuvius—aged for 18 months in oak barrels then in bottle for 24 months—full body, complex, with dark fruit and tobacco notes—beautiful wine

GAGLIOPPO BLEND

Librandi Gravello Val di Neto Rosso 2014—66

The most important wine for the Librandi winery: a beautiful blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Gaglioppo grapes, full body, earthy and smooth

PRIMITIVO

Mottura Primitivo Del Salento 2019 - 31 - Intense ripe red fruit aroma with a dry velvety taste.

Mottura Stilio Primitivo di Manduria 2017 - 120

Unique and interesting Primitivo made in the style of Amarone - the Primitivo grapes are dried before being pressed, giving the wine more bold and robust flavor

INTERNATIONAL STYLE BLENDS

Aia Vecchia Sor Ugo Bolgheri Superiore 2016 - 82

Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot and Petit Verdot—a classic Supertuscan

Marchesi Antinori Il Bruciato 2018- 57

Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Syrah—one of the most affordable Supertuscan wines from one of the most prestigious wineries in Bolgheri and in Italy

Terre di San Leonardo—41

A beautiful blend of 40% merlot, 50% cabernet sauvignon and 10% carmenere from the Dolomites

CARIGNANO

Santadi Grotta Rossa - 38 - **great value**

Carignano del Sulcis is one of the lesser known grapes from Sardinia—full body, earthy yet smooth—a real jewel and one of the best values in this list

CANNONAU

Argiolas Costera - 42

From the island of Sardegna, cannonau is the same grape as garnacha in Spain and Granache in France - deliciously rustic and earthy

DOLCETTO

Fontanabianca Dolcetto d'Alba - 43

Medium body red wine from Piemonte, a great food wine

LAMBRUSCO

Tenuta Pederzana Lambrusco di Castelvetro Gibe - 34

Fruity but dry, lightly sparkly, the classic accompaniment for food from Emilia Romagna, my area of Italy—served chilled, this is a great wine to drink with most of our pastas

Cleto Chiarli Vecchia Modena - 32

Lightly Sparkling with notes of red cherry, strawberry, and tangerine zest—crisp acidity

FREISA

Borgogno Langhe Freisa 2014 - 53

One of the lesser known grapes of Piemonte—medium body, red cherries, pleasant tannins, good acidity

MONTEPULCIANO and MONTEPULCIANO BLENDS

Valle Reale San Calisto 2010 - 100

Organically grown - From the oldest vines at the winery - rich, full body, with soft tannins - award winner every year

Di Majo Norante Ramitello Biferno Rosso - 38

A blend of 80% montepulciano and 20% aglianico from Molise—a great value for the quality of this wine—intense, elegant, with dark fruit, licorice and leather notes—dry but with soft tannins

NEGROAMARO

Mottura Negroamaro 2018 - 31 - Red fruit, licorice and spices. A Harmonic, fresh, smooth wine with balanced tannins.
